

Who can apply for the Artist-in-Residence?

- * All Australian and International practising and emerging artists.
- * Art students over 18 years of age. There are no upper age limits.
- * Artists who wish to share the venue with a collaborative artist or a supportive companion.

Conditions

- * No Accommodation for children or non-residents is available, although visitors are premitted.
- * Pets are not allowed at 89 Mayne Street.
- * Artist-in-residence must comply with Occupational Health and Safety requirements while on the premises.

Applications

- * Must be in English on the attached application form and be accompanied by a current CV.
- * Must be accompanied by a CD containing 6 to 10 JPEG images of work completed. Each image must be identified with the artist's name, title and dimensions of work and date completed.
- * Must contain names and contact details of two referees at least one of whom should be knowledgeable in the applicant's area of art.
- * Artists who apply as callaborators must send individual application forms in a single package along with the collaborative proposal.
- * Must include a proposal stating what the artist hopes to achieve from the residency - how the experience will benefit his/her practice.

Unsuccessful applicants may reapply.

Receipt of all applications will be acknowledged and all support material will be returned to the applicant if requested. Successful applicants will be contacted prior to their allocation date.

Upon notification that the application was successful artists will be required to pay a non-refundable deposit of 10% of the total rental fee and sign the Artist-in-Residence contract.

At the completion of the residency artists will be asked to provide some details about the benefit derived from their Artist-in-Residence experience (optional).



Location

Artists of all persuasions find the historic built environment of Gulgong inspiring as well as the surrounding bushlands and rural scenes.

The town itself is in Central Western NSW 27km from the regional centre Mudgee, 300km from Sydney, 157km from Bathurst and 121km from Dubbo.

Mudgee airport provides daily flights from Sydney and bus /train Country Link service is also available.

Gulgong is known internationally for the clay found in its region.
